PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

The Erasmus Mundus Master's in Food Innovation and Product Design (EMM-FIPDes) is a two year academic programme in the field of food science and product development, operated by Lund University together with AgroParisTech (France), UNINA University (Italy), and DIT (Ireland). The EMM-FIPDes aims to provide a European dimension in the knowledge-intensive area of food research and development and will be highly relevant for both EU and third-country students who wish to be employed in the agri-food and drink sector. The programme was approved by the EU Commission in 2010 and started in 2011.

M1: Food Science and Technology, Innovation/Management/Marketing

M2 specialisations: Food Design and Health, Food Design and Engineering, Food Packaging Design, Master's degree project.

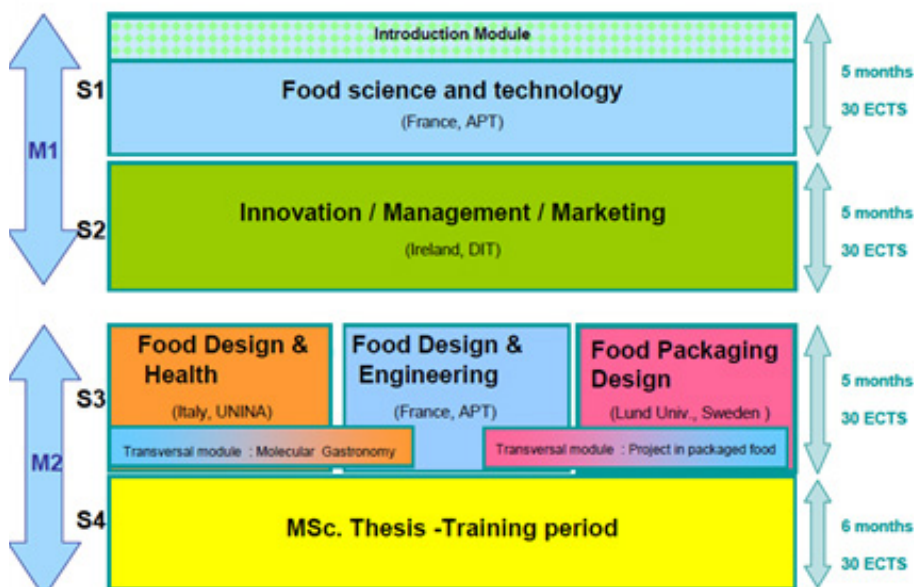
CAREER PROSPECTS

Graduates will be able to find positions in and outside Europe, either in their country or in a national branch of an international food brand.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND HOW TO APPLY

Admission requirements

- BSc degree or equivalent degree of at least 180 higher education credits in food science and technology, biotechnology, process engineering, biochemistry or related fields with a number of prerequisites (e.g. chemistry, biotechnology, process technology/engineering, biochemistry, mathematics, statistics) representing at least three years of study from a foreign institute of higher education.
- Grade point average needs to be at minimum 70% of the maximum score.
- English B (advanced) language proficiency level demonstrated in one of the following ways: TOEFL at level 575 (90 for internet-based TOEFL), IELTS 6.5, Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency. Exemption can be made for students with English as their mother tongue or who have completed a higher education course in English that satisfies eligibility requirements. The Consortium Committee can admit excellent third country students with somewhat lower TOEFL scores.
- Respect of the application deadline.

Selection criteria/additional info

After verifying the admission criteria, students will be selected based on the following qualitative selection criteria:

1. List of subjects taken during the BSc level with grades obtained
2. Educational background including the grade of qualification obtained and, when possible, the world ranking of the university graduating the student
3. Some excellence criteria: experience in laboratory work and/or cooking; additional training/courses/workshops (which are not a part of a regular study programme); participation in conferences and/or publishing of papers in peer reviewed scientific journals; international and work experience
4. Letter of motivation
5. Letters of recommendation
