## PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

The Master programme of Fine Arts in Artistic Research is a two-year full-time education programme. The purpose of the programme is to prepare visual artists in defining and formulating a research project in fine arts that aims at admission to a doctoral programme in this field. Having a distinct international profile, the programme prepares students for professional activities at an international level.

Focus is on the individual research project with which the applicant is accepted and which s/he expands upon during the programme. Based on this project, students are encouraged to develop research questions that emerge from individual research processes and artistic methods. These are discussed and developed in relation to methods that emerge from other relevant research fields in close collaboration with existing academic disciplines. Students are hence stimulated to refine and push their own methods, which are different to those applied in other research fields.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND HOW TO APPLY

### Entry requirements

Bachelor's degree in Music or equivalent and approved entrance examinations.

### How to apply

The applications to Malmö Academy of Music programmes takes place in two steps:

1. **Apply online and submit your supporting documents to University Admissions in Sweden:**
  - **Apply online:** Go to [www.universityadmissions.se](http://www.universityadmissions.se) and find your programme, the Swedish national application website. Click on "Apply" and rank the chosen programmes in order of preference.

- **Submit your supporting documents:** Check what documents you need to submit (i.e. official transcripts, degree diploma/proof of expected graduation, translations, proof of English, passport) and how you need to submit them at [www.universityadmissions.se](http://www.universityadmissions.se).
  - **Pay the application fee (when applicable)**
2. **Entrance examinations:** The examinations usually take place in February/ March each year. Find further information about the application process as well as deadlines and audition instructions for your specialisation on [www.mhm.lu.se](http://www.mhm.lu.se).

### Selection criteria/additional info

Selection of students is based on entrance examinations.

### Tuition fees
