PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

The Master's in information systems provides you with out-standing career opportunities in positions that link technology, people and business.

We offer you a world-class programme that provides you with the tools and skills necessary to understand the design of information systems (is) that address important organisational and societal challenges.

In this programme you will learn how information and communication technologies and artificial intelligence can be used to achieve strategic goals, and how business intelligence help business users make better decisions. You will gain a deeper understanding of the wider business context of information systems and how digitalisation affects organisations.

The courses are designed to help you practice the theory, where sustainability and entrepreneurship are the starting points, that leads you into models and tools on real and complex problems in information systems. You will also learn how to participate in and manage is-related change and innovation projects in national and international contexts..

PROGRAMME MODULES/COURSES

Semester 1

IT, innovation and sustainability; strategic management and information systems; research methods. Choose one: business intelligence; human-computer interaction design.

Semester 2

Select two courses: Business and Artificial Intelligence; Designing Digitalisation; Business Decision Management. The programme ends with a Master's thesis (15 ECTS credits).

CAREER PROSPECTS

Graduates are in high demand, as organisations rely on information systems experts to understand and design systems that help them remain competitive in todays global marketplace.

After graduation, you can pursue a career that links technology, people and business. You can seek positions such as it consultant, is designer, it project manager, business and systems analyst, business process engineer, and business intelligence analyst. The programme is also excellent preparation for phd studies.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND HOW TO APPLY

Entry requirements

An undergraduate degree (BA/BSc) and at least 60 credits (ECTS) of IS related courses. These must include: 1) Foundations and Role of IS, 2) Systems Analysis and Design, 3) Data and Information, 4) Human-Computer Interaction, and 5) Organisation and IS. English Level 6.

How to apply

- **1. Apply online:** Go to: www.lunduniversity.lu.se/information-systems. Click on "Apply" and follow the instructions for the online application at www.universityadmissions.se, the Swedish national application website. Rank the chosen programmes in order of preference.
- 2. Submit your supporting documents:
- General supporting documents: Check what documents you need to submit (i.e. official transcripts, degree diploma/ proof of expected graduation, translations, proof of English, passport) and how you need to submit them at www.universityadmissions.se.
- Programme-specific supporting documents: When applying for the Master's in Information Systems, you must also submit a CV and a statement of purpose with your application. For further instructions, please see www.lusem. lu.se/supporting-documents.
