PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

In a society characterised by increased dynamics and uncertainty, individuals with entrepreneurial skills and mind set are of vast importance. Entrepreneurial skills enable individuals to recognise and exploit opportunities in a start-up, as well as drive innovation in existing organisations. The programme focuses on new venture creation, but also provide knowledge on entrepreneurial processes in existing businesses.

The Master's programme focuses on the process of recognising, testing, validating and exploiting opportunities for value creation. This approach encompasses blended value in terms of the balancing economic, social and environmental sustainability all of which are given attention throughout the programme.

In the programme, you will in teams engage in your own entrepreneurial project. In addition, you will be part of our mentorship programme where you are matched with an experienced mentor. As well as being embedded in the local start-up ecosystem.

Our pedagogy is based on the approach that you need to practice and take action to learn. However, you also need to reflect on your practice and learn from available theories in the field. This is why you will find that our programme in entrepreneurship and innovation embraces action & reflection, without compromising the valuable learning that comes from theory.

PROGRAMME MODULES/COURSES

The programme consists of the following courses: the Entrepreneurial Process and Opportunity Recognition (7.5 ECTS); Business Model Development (5 ECTS); Entrepreneurial Project (15 ECTS); Value Creation (7.5 ECTS); Entrepreneurial Leadership (5 ECTS); Entrepreneurial Finance (5 ECTS); Degree Project (15 ECTS).

CAREER PROSPECTS

The Master's programme in Entrepreneurship and Innovation has an excellent employer reputation. A majority of our graduates are working in a leading role at established companies or managing their own businesses and start-ups, involved in business development and entrepreneurship.

The programme is designed to provide the tools necessary for starting new independent businesses or to work in advisory roles to new venture start-ups. It also gives graduates practical experience in research commercialisation, as well as tools to proactively work in projects in highly uncertain or risky market environments.

The new competitive landscape makes it essential for existing companies to renew and develop. Knowledge of entrepreneurship and innovation processes in general is thus a valuable asset in your future career. The knowledge and skills that follow from the experience and learning from the programme are much sought after by a wide range of organisations.

Entry requirements

An undergraduate degree (BA/BSc). English Level 6.

Selection criteria/additional info

We look for undergraduates with excellent results, demonstrating a strong interest and passion for entrepreneurship and an orientation towards getting things done. When assessing your academic record, we take into account your grade average, your statement of purpose and your CV. Undergraduates are recommended to have a minimum average grade equivalent to 3.0 out of 4, in cumulated grade point average (CGPA), C in the ECTS grading scale, or B in the American grading scale.

Strong English language skills are crucial to gain the full benefit of the programmes we offer. Meeting the minimum English language test requirements does not guarantee admission. A majority of students accepted to this programme submit test scores corresponding to IELTS band 7.0.

Tuition fees

Tuition fee SEK 135 000 per year for non-EU/EEA citizens. No fee for EU/EEA citizens.
